	<p>of strategic productive sectors).</p> <p>This action contributes directly to the achievement of CID Objective 180 (Council Implementing Decision), as stated in the Council Implementing Decision Proposal of 2 October 2023, which amends the Council Implementing Decision (EU) of 13 July 2021, approving the assessment of Spain's Recovery and Resilience Plan.</p> <p>CID Objective 180 establishes that:</p> <p>"Large, high-value, sectoral and interoperable data spaces shall be created in strategic sectors – at least four in the agri-food, sustainable mobility, health, and commerce sectors – in accordance with the Technical Guidance on the Application of the 'Do No Significant Harm' Principle (OJ C 58, 18 February 2021, p. 1), by means of an exclusion list and the requirement to comply with the relevant EU and national environmental legislation. The budget execution mobilised for this purpose shall amount to at least EUR 400,000,000."</p> <p>This CID Objective 180 must be achieved by the second quarter of 2026.</p> <p>On 20 December 2024, the State Secretariat for Digitalisation and Artificial Intelligence published the Award Resolution for the first call for Demonstrators and Use Cases of Data Spaces, through which CESGA was designated as a beneficiary of a grant amounting to EUR 3,077,058 (TSI-100120-2024-12).</p> <p>These contracts will be charged to the budgetary allocation assigned to this project within CESGA's accounts.</p>

PROJECT	Multisectoral DATAlife Demonstrator	The Multisectoral DATAlife Demonstrator aims to enable companies, particularly SMEs and start-ups, to experiment and carry out proof-of-concept projects based on data sharing and exploitation. This will allow the development of innovative practices in the use and exchange of data and in the creation of new products and services, thereby enhancing competitiveness and international visibility. The initiative seeks to reduce the main barriers faced by companies and organisations when sharing data and to promote a robust and

	<p>collaborative data economy.</p> <p>The demonstrator is based on the creation of a decentralised, secure and interoperable platform, aligned with European and international standards, which will provide an environment for sovereign data sharing and exploitation, leveraging the unique computing resources offered by CESGA.</p> <p>Another advantage of the demonstrator is that it will be based on a packaged system (data space as a service), as well as on open-source software components and technology developed in Spain. These components will be able to evolve independently of third parties to meet user specifications and to converge with standards that enable their integration with other interoperable demonstrators and the European common data spaces currently under development.</p> <p>The MULTISECTORAL DATALIFE DEMONSTRATOR Project, funded by the Ministry for Digital Transformation and the Civil Service, aims to provide access to, and secure sovereign mechanisms for, data sharing, together with a cloud infrastructure equipped with state-of-the-art and high-performance computing resources, both hardware and software.
